PURPOSE



District Designated Funds (DDF) are the only way to multiply your club contribution. TRF matches DDF .8-to-1 on Global Grants, so getting a DDF match through your district will nearly TRIPLE your club's donation!

HOW IT WORKS



Contact your District Rotary Foundation Chair (DRFC).*

Tell them you are interested in a DDF match for your club's contribution to Basic Education & Literacy Global Grant #2578323, hosted by the Rotary Clubs of Guatemala Vista Hermosa and Fruita, CO.

Ask for a match for your contribution.

Usually the district will match your club contribution dollar-for-dollar. Some districts will match two- or three-to-one. Ask if the district requires any paperwork from your club before they will be able to approve the match.

Your DG & DRFC authorize contributions!

After the grant financing is finalized in January 2026, The Rotary Foundation will email your DG and DRFC asking them to authorize your district's DDF match in My Rotary.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?



The DDF match unlocked through YOUR club's gift will be combined with other district contributions on Global Grant #2578323, making it eligible for ADDITIONAL matching funds through The Rotary Foundation (pending approval).
